Use broad hangers that support the shoulder area for [dresses](#), [suits](#) and [shirts](#). By doing this, you will be able to avoid sagging and distortion during the drying process.

To enhance the airflow, leave adequate space between clothing items. In addition to slowing the drying process, crowded lines retain moisture. Whether your drying area is indoors or outdoors, make sure it has consistent ventilation. Proper spacing guarantees clean drying and lesser odours.

Dry whites in the sun. Without the use of chemicals, natural light brightens and [removes stains from clothing](#). Select shaded spots for coloured clothing to avoid fading. To protect the neckline, hang knitwear and T-shirts upside down. This method maintains shape and elasticity.

For dresses, shirts and other structured items, use hangers. During the drying process, hangers maintain the shape of clothing. This method [keeps clothes crisp](#) and cuts down on ironing time. Whenever possible, make sure that the garments are facing the breeze. Consistent airflow avoids damp spots and accelerates evaporation.

Steer clear of overlapping clothing because trapped moisture causes odours and delays drying. Dust and dew settle on damp fabric, so never leave clothing outside overnight. Thin ropes should not be
